SAFETY TIPS

Wear Life Jackets (PFDs): Ensure that everyone on board wears a properly fitted and U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket at all times. Make sure you have enough life jackets for all passengers.

File a Float Plan: Let someone on land know your boating plans, including your destination, expected return time, and contact information. This way, someone can alert authorities if you don't return as planned.

Know Your Boat: Familiarize yourself with your boat's operation, including how to start and stop the engine, use the navigation and safety equipment, and handle emergency situations.

Check the Weather: Before heading out, check the weather forecast for the area you'll be boating in. Avoid going out in rough weather, storms, or high winds.

Avoid Alcohol and Drugs: Boating under the influence of alcohol or drugs is illegal in most places and significantly impairs your judgment and reaction time.


